

Swords in 20 Words or Less

This was an exercise I did as part of 2022's Swordtember art challenge, which challenges artists to create a sword each day in September based on a prompt.

The additional challenge I gave myself is originally from a thread from Ivory (@DeathMeetAuthor) on Twitter where they described a writing exercise they developed for an intern. The challenge is to write 20 sword descriptions using only a 20-word limit, including the sword name.

I modified this a bit, creating three groups of 10 swords, each group with its own additional limitations (rarity, type, genre, etc). I wrote these descriptions a week before the start of September and once Swordtember began, I selected descriptions that best matched the given prompt. In the end, I loosely followed their 'no reusing descriptors' rule as some prewritten descriptions needed revision to better fit the art prompt.

This is a selection of those Swordtember entries.

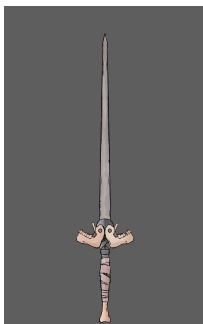


Title: BRUTALITY DIAMOND

Description:

An old rapier reinforced in a high-temperature crystal cave. Fine edges engineered into a vicious weapon.

Prompt: Crystal

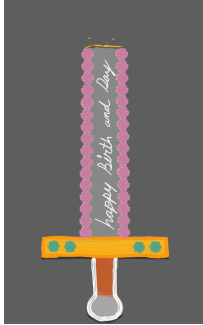


Title: RESTORED SKELETAL REAVER

Description:

Rough, intimidating, and deadly. Used by marauders to attack and strike fear.

Prompt: Skeleton

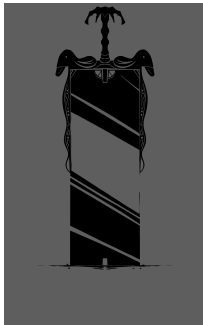


Title: DISMAY

Description:

Probably the best outcome from sword shopping online after a bottle of wine. Cake reads 'Happy Birth and Day.'

Prompt: Edible



Title: DANGER MIRROR

Description:

Untouched by combat and polished to perfection, used by a vain yet powerful warrior king.

Prompt: Mirror



Title: DISCARDED SWORD

Description:

Thrown away by a nobleman after suffering cosmetic damage. Perfectly functional.

Prompt: Gaudy



Title: BOUQUET OF DEATH

Description:

When one won't do. A fine selection of cutlery wrapped in a lethal arrangement.

Prompt: Floral



Title: CONSTRUCT DESTROYER

Description:

Wield the power of a singularity!

Prompt: Void

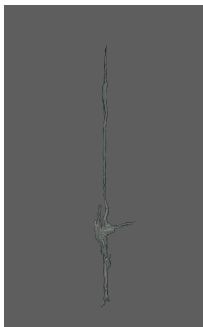


Title: GIANT'S SPATULA

Description:

Prompt: Dual-purpose



Title: RELIC OF A LOST WAR

Description:

Eroded beyond use or recognition.

Prompt: Rot



Title: HOLLOW VICTORY

Description:

Is it a real sword? No, but in a pinch it IS a weapon.

Prompt: Topiary

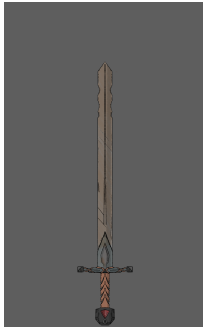


Title: RANGER'S ALLY

Prompt: Moss

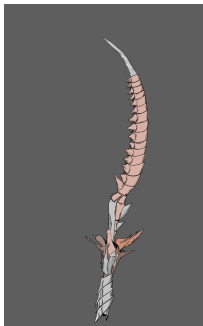


Title: ANTIQUE DOOMBLADE

Prompt: Nordic

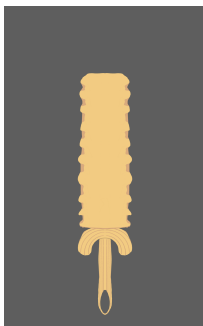


Title: WARSTALKER

Description:

Description:

Description:

Prompt: Pattern

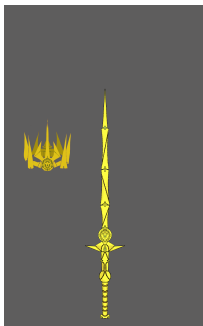


Title: PAIN TRASH

Description:

Prompt: Asymmetrical



Title: DEFENDER

Description:

Designed by a royal mechanist, this crown unfurls to a short sword within seconds. A weak but effective option.

Prompt: Crown, Monochromatic
