
Welbro 11A Stealth System (Star Wars Spec)



Star Wars: Rebel Assassin is a bit of a fan project and an exercise in working within an existing IP. Essentially a Star Wars version of Sniper Elite or Metal Gear Solid. A core component of the game would be a modular primary weapon that acts as both sniper rifle and combat pistol.

The following are two sets of in-game text for the weapon. One from the weapon's inventory item description, and another as a longer codex entry.

▼ In-Game Item Description

The Welbro 11A Stealth System is a modular blaster system designed to be smuggled across checkpoints, disguised as an assortment mechanical parts and tools.

The weapon is configurable as either a blaster pistol or a long-range sniper rifle, both perfect for silent attacks. A secondary handle acts as an adapter for most common Imperial power cells, turning the weapon into a standard yet highly accurate blaster.

▼ In-Game Codex Version

The Welbro 11A Stealth System is a modular blaster system designed for Infiltrators and covert operations. The system is made to be broken down and smuggled across checkpoints, blending in with most mechanical parts and tools.

The weapon was designed and built by Welbro Olen, a resistance technician. The idea originated from her time undercover as an Imperial mechanic and the need to have a defensive weapon on hand in areas where she was only allowed tools and parts.

The weapons system can be used as either a blaster pistol or a long-range sniper rifle. Both configurations work in either stealth or assault mode. Stealth mode utilizes a special power cell integrated into its main handle, allowing the weapon to fire quiet, nearly-invisible bolts. A secondary handle turns the weapon into a typical blaster and acts as an adapter for most common Imperial power cells.

Even though the 11A was built primarily as a covert weapon, rebel operative and fellow engineer Elarond Abeeso was able to modify the weapon into a more adaptive weapons system. On one documented occasion, Abeeso used the core components as part of a makeshift heavy artillery blaster capable of disabling an AT-ST. Though these techniques severely damaged key components of the weapon.
